On 17 September 1999, at about 4.10pm, I was shown for the second time a piece identified as DP31, the second smallest section of the whole original motorcycle fragment from a Webo MSTB tunnel.

I examined this article again under a magnifying glass of 10x magnification and established that it was light brown in colour. This is not the same colour as the rest of the larger motorcycle fragment, which was green.

I suggested that 2 CID or forensic officers are called as witnesses so that they can confirm what colour they see, and they could then prepare statements to that effect.

Despite repeated requests to do this, my suggestion was rejected by Principal Prosecutor Fiscal Miss Weber, and the Manager of the Crown Office, and they gave as a reason that I was here as a witness and as such I could not call for other witnesses.

They also confirmed that they had recorded my comments in their own notebooks, and that they would carry out the necessary investigations.

I also wish to add the following to this statement.

On Tuesday 14 September 1999, in the presence of the Principal Prosecutor's Fiscal Deputa Miss Weber and Mr. Harvie of the Northern Criminal Investigation Team, I was shown the alleged original piece of evidence of an MSTB tunnel fragment, which was allegedly found at the Pan Am 103 airplane dived by the investigating authorities.

It was confirmed to me that a photograph identified as PT/35 (b), on page 336 of the investigation files was identical with the fragment that I was shown.

The fragment I was shown is green in color, presumably from Thuring, and is such presumably from MEBO. It is not identical to the three prototypes built by Mr. Humpert.

Shortly before 5pm on Friday 17 September 1999, at this point in my statement, Mr. Harvie

interrupted us and asked me to return to
the Crown Office room on the top floor of
the Police Station.

5 I accompanied him to that room along
with the chief visiting his statement (DC Brown)
and the interpreter.

10 Miss Nelson then told me that she would
allow me, plus an independent Police
chief, to view the particles referred to.
She said that the Police chief would
be asked to remember what colour the
15 items were, and to provide a statement
to that effect.

20 A short while later a female chief came
into the room (DI Thomson). This chief and
I then viewed items PT35(b) and DP31. The
chief was asked not to say what colour
she saw, just to remember it.

25 Once we had viewed these articles, the
chief and I signed labels attached to
each.
